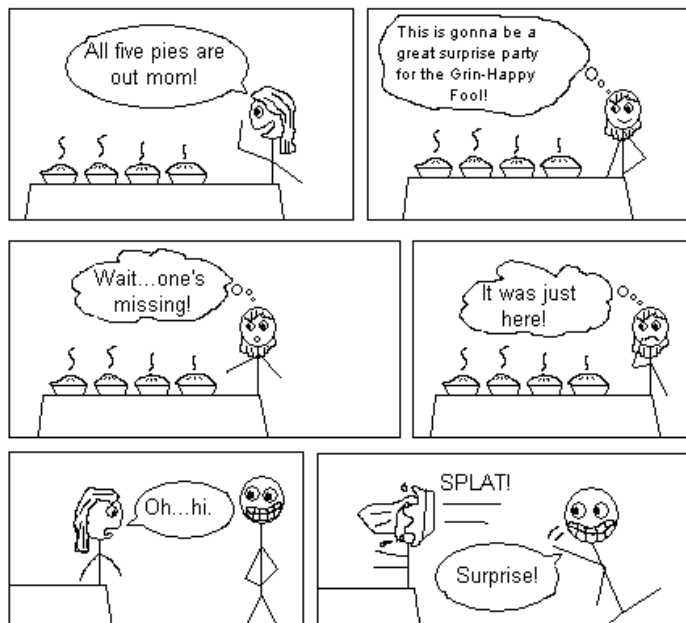
Note from the office
